School Data

The new National curriculum was assessed in 2016 for the first time. New tests with higher expectations were taken by children at the end of year 2 and year 6. It is no longer possible to compare school results to previous year's results as children no longer receive a numbered level. In place of levels children are assessed to check whether they have achieved the expected standard. Some children may achieve standards above those expected by children of their age and will be judged to be working at greater depth.
