 Work on Times Table Rockstars – your child will have an individual login to access this (20 minutes each day). Competitions are available to challenge the children. Daily 4 calculations – see calculation sheet. Aim for 80% comprehension level. Encourage your child to read for at least 20 minutes independently. Ask them to summarise what they have read and make predictions as to what might happen next. They could do this orally or write a short summary. Listen to your child read aloud discuss together what they have read. Encourage them to read with expression and intonation.

LESSONS • <u>Multiply Proper Fractions and Mixed Numbers by</u> <u>Whole Numbers</u> <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=DSIOOno1c4A</u> <i>Example of multiplying proper fractions by a whole</i> <i>number:</i> $5 \times \frac{3}{7} =$ First turn the whole number into a fraction by putting a 1 as the denominator. $\frac{5}{1} \times \frac{3}{7} =$ Multiply the numerators together = 15 Multiply the denominators together = 7 So, the answer would equal $\frac{15}{7} = 2\frac{1}{7}$ <i>Example of multiplying mixed numbers by whole</i> <i>numbers:</i> $3 \times 1\frac{2}{5} =$ First turn the mixed number into an improper fraction, $1\frac{2}{5}$ would become $\frac{7}{5}$	 Using Inference (Looking for Clues) Watch the lesson and complete the activities by following the link below. https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/zntr47h The F.A. cup Read the poem and answer the comprehension questions. Teacher tips

Let the children lead their learning, if they are interested in a particular thing let them explore it and where possible make links with other things as children learn more if they enjoy it.
