This term we are studying World War II during our History lessons. In addition, we are reading stories and poetry inspired by this period in history - *Goodnight Mr Tom and Friend or Foe*. This literature is helping us to understand what life was like during this period.

Project Task

To develop independent research skills, creativity and writing the pupils have been asked to produce a project linked to World War II. Some possible suggestions are:

- The Blitz
- Rationing
- Evacuation
- The home front
- Jobs and the role of women

Your project should include:

- Title page
- Report writing
- Pictures/drawings
- Writing linked to the project - letters, diaries, posters, leaflets, reports etc...
- Contents page and Glossary
- Any other information that you think is relevant

This task is intended to be meaningful and fun. School will provide paper, card etc...but the intention is for each child to present a project independently in their own way. Please use books and the internet for research, but copying chunks from the internet will not be acceptable as this is not your work. Work should be completed by **Friday 6th November**.
