Event Details:

Location: – Yoko Ono Lennon Centre, building number 816, grid reference G4 on the map. The ceremony itself will take place in Lecture theatre 1. when you enter the building from the main entrance, it is on the ground floor, opposite the café.

Date: **Thursday 2nd July**

Time: **10:15 AM**

Please arrive **15 minutes before** the start of the ceremony and take your seat in the lecture theatre while the children are fitted with their graduation cap and gown. (Tip: For comfort and fit, we recommend that pupils wear their hair down and avoid large hair accessories.)

Additional Information:

- The ceremony will last approximately **one hour**.
- Each graduate is allocated **two guests**.
- Due to limited space, we kindly ask that parents **do not bring additional guests including infants**.
- Following the ceremony, there will be time for you to take personal photographs with your child.
- Official event photography will also be available to purchase afterwards. If you do **not** wish for your child to be photographed, please inform your child's school in advance.
- Caps and Gowns must be returned after the ceremony.

Travel & Parking:

There is no designated parking at the University, so if you are travelling by car you will need to find somewhere suitable to park and walk across to the building. There is pay and display on the surrounding roads or Paddington Village car park (L7 8SY), Liverpool Metropolitan Cathedral, Mount Pleasant (L3 5TQ)
