Can you retell a story to your adult or family member before bed? Year One would be looking at fantasy stories so if you can, access YouTube and look for Baboon on the Moon. Listen to the story first and encourage your child to guess what the story is about based on what they hear. Watch the video- was you correct? Oxford owl- select a book of your child's choice and let them be teacher.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Phonics task - Revision: Write as many words as you can think of with the sounds igh and ow (as in blow the snow) in – how many can you think of in 3 minutes? Challenge: Can you use your words in sentences? Word challenge How many words can you find using only the letters in the grid? Take your time or for an extra challenge ask your grown up to time you! What's the longest word you can find? What's the shortest word you can find? Can you find more than 5 words? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> After listening to Baboon on the Moon – write a short description of what you think the story is about. After watching Baboon on the Moon- write a character description describing the main character and his strange appearance. Remember capital letters CL, full stops . commas, finger spaces and 'Fred Fingers' when sounding words out.

Science and Foundation subjects/learning projects- to be done throughout the week

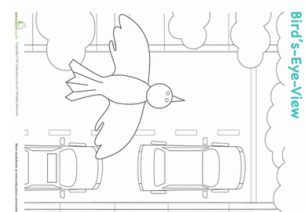
- Science – look at classification of animals based on food habits you tube video, using your animal toys or writing a list, group the animals by what they eat. Research what other animals eat.

Teacher tips

Let the children lead their learning, if they are interested in a particular thing let them explore it and where possible make links with other things as children learn more if they enjoy it. Don't feel that your child needs to do all activities suggested – you might use this as a guide and think of something similar that is more suited to your child's own interests and ability.

Breaks are important- Children cannot concentrate for long periods of time and need to have time built in for them to switch off. Try PE with Joe wicks or Cosmic Yoga on YouTube to get the children moving and enable them to burn off some energy.
