Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Year- One would be looking at stories from different cultures. Look on you tube for the story 'Handa's Surprise' and discuss this book/story with your family. What was your favourite part? Can you remember what happened at the beginning, middle, end etc
- BookTrust –'Getting children reading' is a free online resource that has a variety of interactive books to read or watch with signing.
- Get your adult to write some words from Handa's Surprise ie Ostrich, tangerines- can you spell them?
- Continue to read your favourite stories to your adult.

Weekly Spelling/Phonics tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- Phonics play have comics 'Lets Go. ' look at sounds ai, ee, igh and oa
- Can you write as many words as you can containing the sounds above.
- Recap these sounds using phonics play, phonics bloom sites.
- Play [Help a Hedgehog](#) select the phoneme you would like to practise, read the word and click the tick if you say it correctly.

Weekly Writing tasks (Aim to do 1 per day)

- After watching Handa's Surprise on Youtube, describe Handa's journey. What animals did she meet and what fruit did she see?
- Can you describe one of the animals using adjectives we have learnt already ie huge, fury, fierce, pointy etc
- Can you write an alternative story ie Sarah's surprise, choose different animals and fruit

Science and Foundation subjects/learning projects- to be done throughout the week

- Science – look up parts of a plant clip on Youtube, draw a plant and label the parts. Can you remember what each part is responsible for?
- Youtube- parts of the plant song
- DT – Make a fruit salad using some of the fruits from Handa's Surprise- What fruit did you like the most/least. How could you improve it?
- Art – Create some paintings or drawings of the animals and fruit from the Handa's Surprise story.
- Geography – Look at how trees change over the four seasons and draw pictures of how the trees look in spring, summer, autumn and winter. What changes? Why do you think this happens? Collect some leaves on your next walk or from your garden. Take them home and have a go at sketching different leaves.

Teacher tips

Let the children lead their learning, if they are interested in a particular thing let them explore it and where possible make links with other things as children learn more if they enjoy it. Don't feel that your child needs to do all activities suggested – you might use this as a guide and think of something similar that is more suited to your child's own interests and ability.

Breaks are important- Children cannot concentrate for long periods of time and need to have time built in for them to switch off. Try PE with Joe wicks or Cosmic Yoga on YouTube to get the children moving and enable them to burn off some energy.
