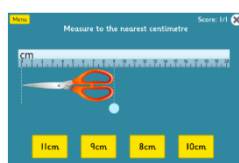


- Complete a book review of the story- would you recommend it?
